2010 SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS

1. The deadline for returning completed application, required documentation, and essay is Sunday, April 20, 2010.
2. Scholarship application require essay.
3. Proof of Fall 2010 registration/enrollment at a tuition-based private school must be included with the application.
4. Church membership requirement - Parent of the student must be a member of ETBC for minimum of one (1) year as of September 1, 2010.
5. All essays must be type-written. Include the student's name, the parent's name and parent's church envelope number at the top of each page of the essay.
6. Scholarship applicants are required to attend the Enon Student Recognition Service which will be held on Saturday, June 13, 2010 at 5:00 pm where the recipients will be announced.
